HORTICULTURE SHOW SCHEDULE AND RULES

1. Entries will be accepted from 11:00 to 12:30 on Friday. Up to three entries total per exhibitor.
2. Entrants should provide their own clear glass containers for exhibiting- we will have a few extras on hand.
3. Entry cards will be available at the registration desk for the conference. Please have your plant names in advance, ready to fill in on the cards because our schedule is tight. Botanical name if possible and the variety or cultivar name.
4. Judging will begin at 1:00 p.m.

Class One-Annuals	Three specimens of small flowers, one of larger flowers
Class Two-Perennials	Three specimens of small flowers, one of larger flowers
Class Three-Vegetables	Three specimens of tomatoes, peppers, onions, summer squash and other smaller vegetables; one of large vegetables
Class Four-Fruits	One specimen of larger fruits, six specimens of smaller fruit such as berries
Class Five-Herbs	Three stems of small herbs, one stem of large herbs
Class Six-Corms, bulbs, tubers	One specimen
Class 7-Orchids	One in any size pot
Class 8-Flowering plant or plants in a pot	One container any size
Class 9-Foliage plant or plants in a pot	One container any size
Class 10-Hanging basket	One container any size
Class 11-Fairy Garden	One container any size
Class 12-Trees and Shrubs	One branch not less than 12" and not more than 30"
Class 13-Miscellaneous	One specimen of anything not already listed above
